SHORT FILM SHOOTING IN KINGSTON THIS JANUARY

'The Origin of Teddy Bears' seeks extras for local shoot

Kingston – Fauxhemian Films is pleased to announce the first location shoot for their short film 'The Origin of Teddy Bears', January 4th - 10th, 2010 at the Grand Theatre and other locations around the Kingston area.

Winners of a project grant from the City of Kingston Arts Fund, and sponsored by the Kingston Canadian Film Festival, Fauxhemian Films are seeking extras to appear in the film.

"Our film is about an alternative universe where Teddy Bears are the deliverers of bad news," says J. Adam Brown, Director of the film. "We're looking for extras to appear as regular people in the background of outdoor shots, there are even some speaking roles still to be filled. We're looking for people of all ages and backgrounds. It's going to be a lot of fun and we're looking forward to seeing lots of people from the Kingston community come out for the shoot."

Brown and his creative partner, writer Blain Watters, have also begun an online fundraising campaign to help finance the film. "We were fortunate to receive really generous arts grants from the province, and the city. But we'll need a little more help to finish the film. That's where Kingstonians come in!" chuckles Brown.
