



KCFF Volunteer Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is required to volunteer?

A. Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older. A cell phone number and email address are needed for program communications. No previous volunteer experience is required.

Q. When are volunteers needed?

A. February 26 to March 2nd, 2025.

Q. What types of jobs will volunteers be doing?

A. We are looking for Greeters, Ushers, Event Supporters and more.

Q. Where is the festival taking place?

A. The event will be taking place across a variety of venues in downtown Kingston, ON.

Q. What do I get in return for volunteering?

A. In addition to the reward of being part of a premiere Canadian event, celebrating some of Canada's directors, actors, cinematographers and editors, meeting new people and making new friends, you will also receive a volunteer t-shirt and volunteer accreditation that is yours to keep. Pending capacity, volunteers may be able to sit in on screenings during volunteer shifts, so you'll have access to some of the best Canadian films of the year! In addition, volunteers are invited to our Awards

Party, where we'll present the People's Choice Award (and others) and celebrate with new friends over delicious food and drink!

Q. How does scheduling work?

A. Selected volunteers are able to self-schedule on the interactive Volunteer Portal, choosing their own shift and assignment based on skill set and availability at the time of scheduling.

Q. How long are shifts?

A. Shifts vary in length, though we try to keep most to approximately 3-6 hours, depending on the role. Details will be available once the schedule opens for sign up.

Q. When does the application close?

A. We will continue to accept applications until our needs are met.

Q. When will we find out if we are selected?

A. It will take some time to review applications but we will start notifying those selected as soon as we can. Applicants will be kept up to date on the program via email and the Volunteer Portal.

Q. Is parking included?

A. Unfortunately we are unable to provide complimentary parking.
